The recent report by the Energy and Climate Change Committee on the GB Smart Metering Programme was critical of the current supplier-led approach, questioning of technical barriers, urged speedier action in extending population reach and accelerating deployment, and challenged the degree of enduring consumer engagement in the overall process. Both Government and Ofgem rejected many of the assertions of the Committee's report, but it is a timely and terse reminder of the challenges yet to be overcome to deliver an enduring roll-out programme from April 2016.

Whatever your particular view on the current status of the smart metering programme, it is clear that an integrated supply chain approach is paramount in solving outstanding technical and commercial issues ahead of full implementation.

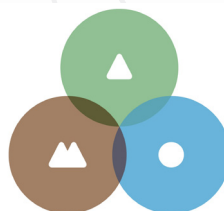
